New Guidelines for In Person Worship

We're pleased to announce the following new guidelines worship:

1. We are returning to two services on June 6!

- 9 a.m. Contemporary Service with a new Children's Chapel available during worship
- 11 a.m. Traditional Service with Organ & Liturgy
- Childcare will be provided for both services.

2. Online Services Continue

Services will continue to be available online on our Facebook page (www.facebook.com/ FPCElkRapids1874) and our website at www.erfpc.org for those who choose to worship from home.

Everyone is encouraged to take into consideration their own health and decide whether to worship in the sanctuary or at home. We are doing everything to be as safe as possible, but there are still risks in gathering.

3. <u>Masks are no longer required for fully</u> vaccinated adults.

However, masks are still required for unvaccinated adults and children over 2.

4. No reservations are required. Just come as you are able!

- 5. We will continue to Limit Numbers in Sanctuary to provide for safe distancing. We will allow up to 60 people per Sunday in the sanctuary and up to 30 in the Fellowship Hall for sanctuary overflow to ensure the appropriate social distance. Families may sit together.
- 6. Singing will be allowed in both services. Hymnals will be in pews for the Traditional Service.
- 7. Food is still not permitted in the church building, but you may Bring Your Own Beverage
- 8. Socialize Outdoors

Beginning Sunday, June 6 coffee will be available outside between services. This will be a great time to get caught up with friends you haven't seen in a while!

9. Love One Another still applies! Your patience, kindness, and understanding are sincerely appreciated!
